

BASKETBALL REGISTRATION

The Taft Parents Athletic Association will hold registration for the 2021-2022 basketball season!

THURSDAY, SEPT. 30, 2021
From 6-8 PM

For all THIRD, FOURTH, FIFTH and SIXTH GRADE boys and girls!
Sports physicals are required for all athletes and forms can be obtained at your doctor's office.
They must be turned in to the school nurse prior to your child practicing.

Players in 4th-6th grades will receive a uniform of a reversible jersey and shorts. We will take uniform orders at registration for any player who needs a new uniform. The cost for a complete uniform is \$45. Cash or check made payable to TPAA. Sample pieces will be available to try on at registration. A new jersey is \$25 and new shorts are \$20 if you don't need a complete set.

Third grade players will order a T-shirt for \$15. Black shorts will be worn in a game.

The Sports Fee is \$100 (cash or check made payable to TPAA). Money is used for tournament entry fees and game referees.

We are also collecting a \$100 volunteer deposit (separate check made payable to TPAA). The volunteer fee is \$100 per family. The volunteer deposit will be returned once FIVE hours of volunteer time is completed during the 75th annual Taft Tournament to be held in January 2022. If you choose not to volunteer at the tournament, we will deposit your check.

All fees must be paid before a player will be allowed to participate. You must pay in cash or check; no ePay allowed. No uniforms will be ordered unless they are paid for.

- Check/cash for \$100 for Taft Tournament volunteer fee
